

Sustainability Features of Norton Healthcare Goodwill Opportunity Campus

The Norton Healthcare Goodwill Opportunity Campus being constructed at the corner of 28th Street and Broadway in West Louisville will positively impact 50,000 individuals each year with its collection of self-sufficiency resources provided by Goodwill and its co-locating partners. But the community isn't the only beneficiary – the Opportunity Campus will also help the environment.

The project team overseeing construction of the Opportunity Campus has prioritized sustainability by including environmentally friendly features to reduce ongoing utility and maintenance costs and yearly operating costs by roughly 25%, which will in turn promote and maintain a cleaner environment.

Sustainability features of the Opportunity Campus include:

- A white roof to reflect heat (pictured)
- · Increase in insulation for efficiency
- Natural lighting (example pictured) and automatic lighting systems that include occupancy sensors
- 95% high efficiency gas boilers for HVAC systems and 12.4 IEER for cooling efficiency
- Underground infiltration drainage system
- Exterior green space to reduce site heat blooming
- Repurposed furniture
- Post-consumer, carbon-neutral recycled carpeting
- · Materials and equipment built
