Donating to Goodwill Kentucky is a simple way to make a meaningful impact across Kentucky. When you donate gently used clothing, household items, electronics, and more, those donations are sold in our Goodwill Kentucky stores, and the revenue directly funds job training, education programs, and career services in support of our mission of helping Kentuckians find pathways out of poverty. Rather than going to waste in a landfill, your items get a second life while helping individuals gain skills, find jobs, and build more stable futures. When you give to Goodwill, you do a lot of good. Thank you for helping Goodwill end poverty in Kentucky.

Goodwill Kentucky gratefully accepts a wide variety of donated items, including clothing, household goods, and furniture. However, for safety, environmental, and regulatory reasons, **there are some items we are unable to accept or resell**. Many of these guidelines are informed by safety standards, including those from the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission.

Items we cannot accept include:

- Baby cribs and baby walkers
- Mattresses and box springs
- Gas or kerosene containers
- Chemicals or paint
- Large appliances (such as refrigerators and stoves)
- Vehicle tires and batteries
- Compressed air cylinders
- Bean bag chairs
- Motorcycle helmets
- Children's metal jewelry
- Antique toys that may contain lead-based paint
- Furniture that is broken, heavily worn, stained, or missing pieces

Firearms, BB guns, Airsoft, Paintball, Compressed Air Rifles:

Goodwill Kentucky does not accept any items that shoot or launch projectiles using compressed air, air cylinders, or ammunition.
